



Student-to-Faculty Ratio

Private, non-AHC programs in the X Census Division

Introduction

This report summarizes student-to-faculty ratio for private, non-AHC PA programs in the X Census Division. The data and methods used are from PAEA's [Program Report 34](#), published October 2019. Data from this report were collected during Fall 2018, which are the most recent data available at this time.

Methods

The initial student-to-faculty dataset conforms to the criteria described in Section 3 of Program Report 34 (PR34). Each program's student-to-faculty ratio (SFR) was calculated in two ways. For Table 1 (based on PR34 Table 40), SFR was calculated by dividing each program's total number of enrolled students by their full-time faculty headcount. In Table 2 (based on PR34 Table 41), SFR was calculated by dividing each program's total number of enrolled students by the sum of their filled faculty, program director, and medical director FTEs.
